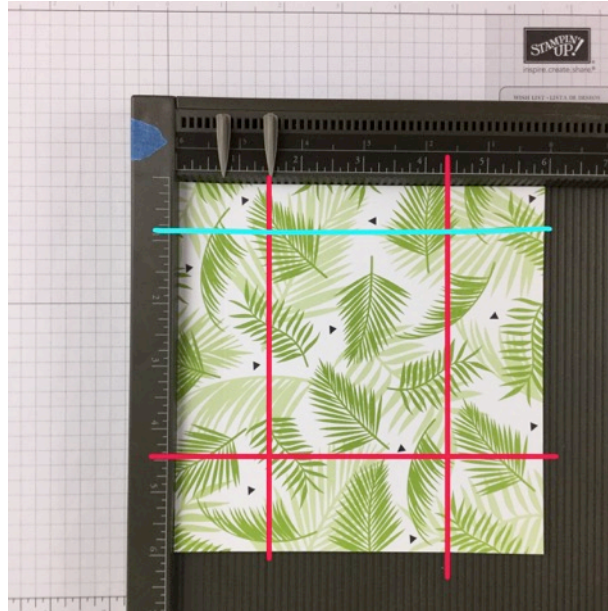


There's plenty of time to whip up a handful of these Easter Goodie Bags, as they are quick and easy.

- 1) Start with two 6x6 pieces of designer paper
- 2) On both sheets of paper, score three sides at 1.5" and one side at .75 inches (this is the top, so if your patterned paper is one-directional, you'll need to know which way is up.)



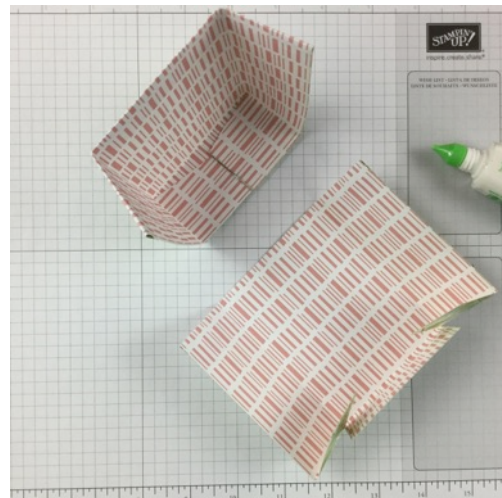
- 3) Glue the top flap down with multipurpose glue



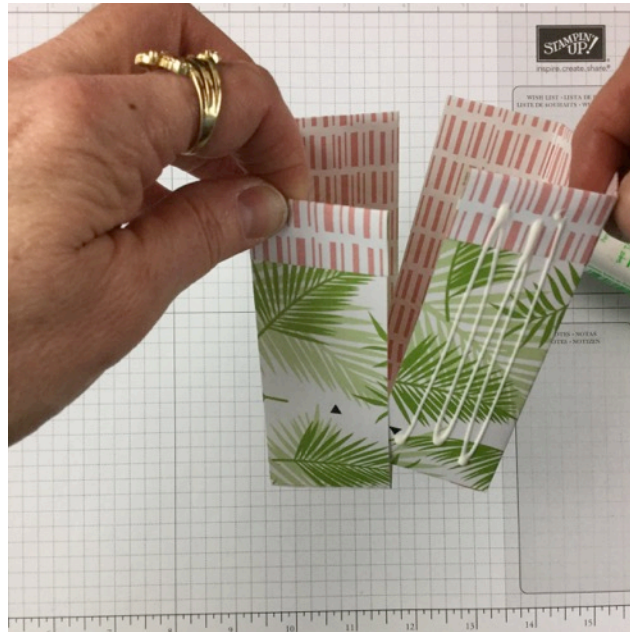
- 4) Cut on the two score lines as shown, and miter the inside edges of each flap.



- 5) Burnish the score lines, add multipurpose glue to each flap and adhere under the larger middle flap as shown



- 6) Nest the two halves together. Do this with no glue first, as usually it will fit and look better one way versus the other. Then add glue to the two sides and bottom of the inner nesting half and insert into the outer half.



- 7) Decorate as desired



- 8) Fill with goodies and gift away
