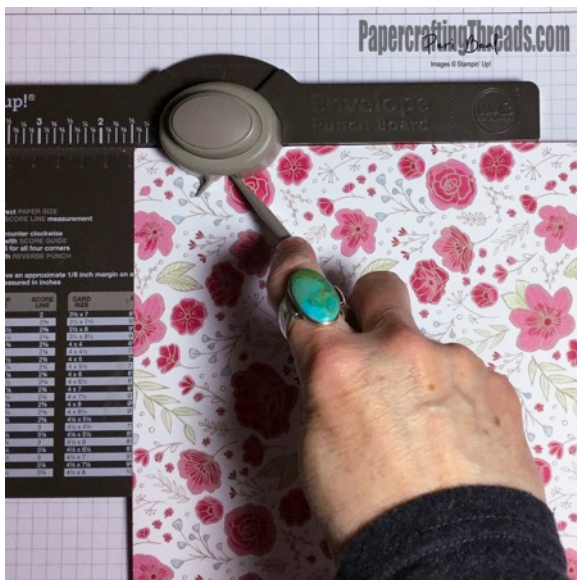




This cute gift pouch starts with only two measurements on the Envelope Punch Board and whips up quickly from one sheet of double-sided Designer Series Paper. Who will you make one (or two) for?

1. Insert DSP into under slot of Envelope Punch Board (EPB) with left edge lined up at the 1 ½” mark, punch, and score with the bone folder all the way to the edge of the EPB. Be very careful not to go off the edge, as you’ll poke a hole in your paper.

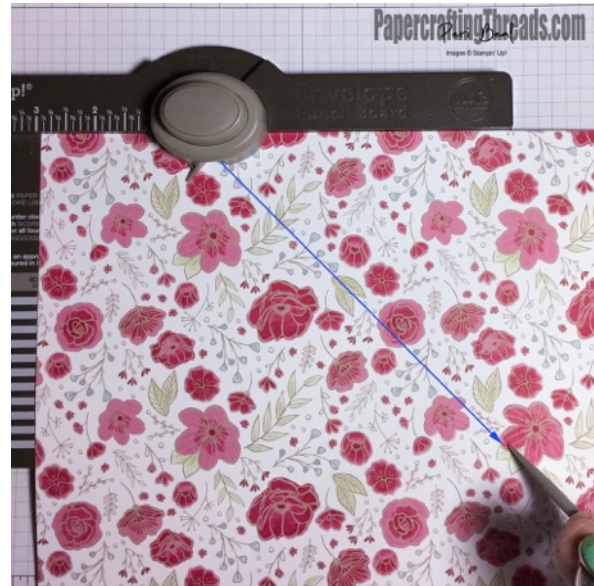


2. Turn DSP ninety degrees and line up the left edge at the 3” mark, punch, and score with the bone folder all the way to the edge of the EPB.

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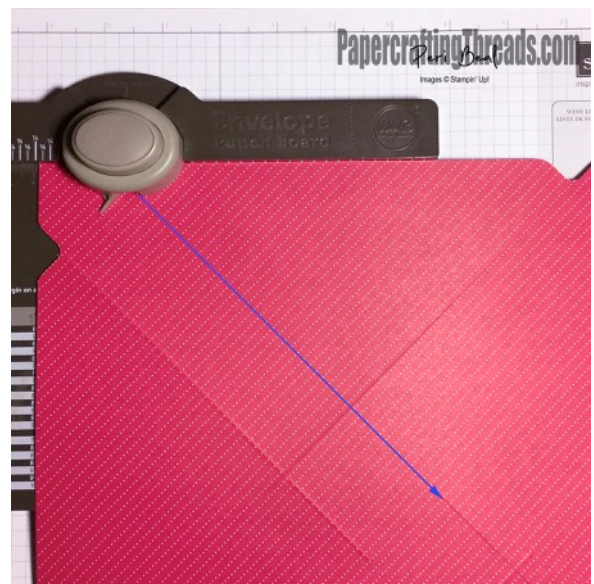

3. Turn paper ninety degrees, and repeat Step 1, line up the left edge at 1 1/2" mark, punch and score.

4. Again, turn paper ninety degrees, and repeat Step 2, line up the left edge at the 3" mark, punch and score.

5. Flip the paper over to the reverse side. Repeat steps 1 through 4 on this side, choosing the 3" mark when the previous punch indent around the corner was at the 3" point, and choosing the 1 1/2" mark when it's kitty corner to another 1 1/2" mark.

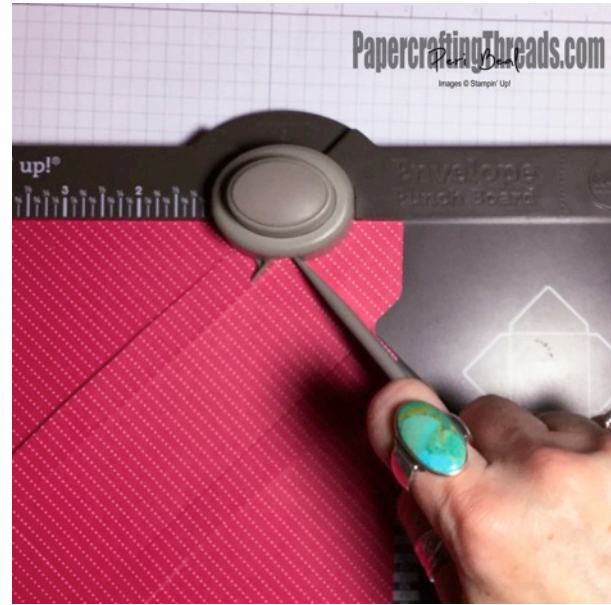


6. Line up the score lines on each corner as show and score flaps as shown on each of the four corners as shown below.

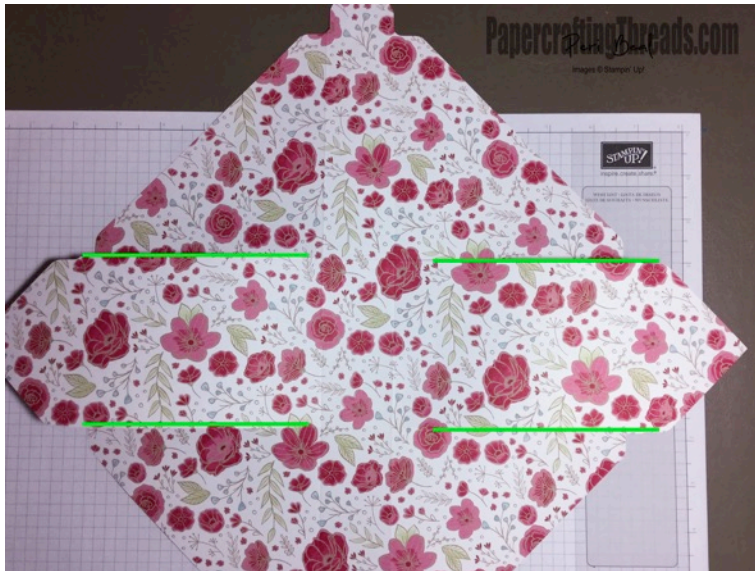

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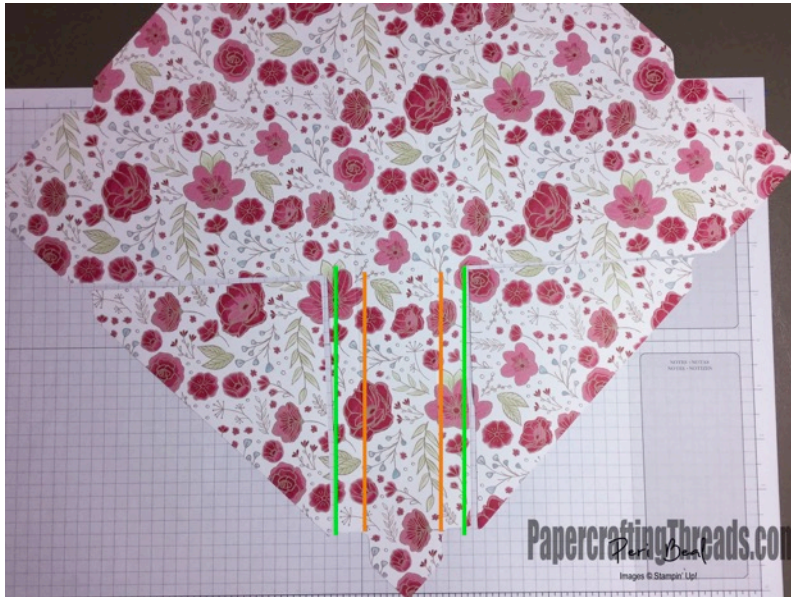

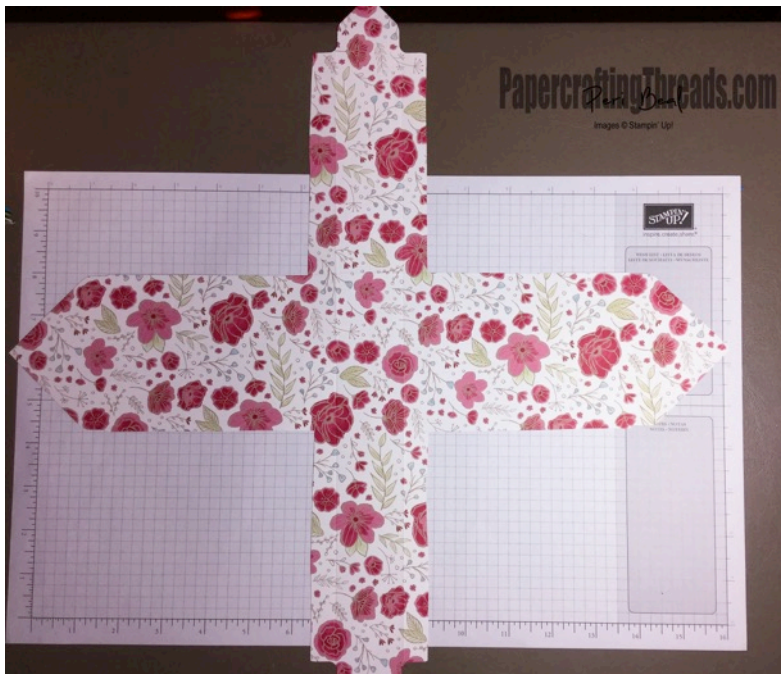
7. Cut the wider sections of score lines as marked by the green lines shown below.



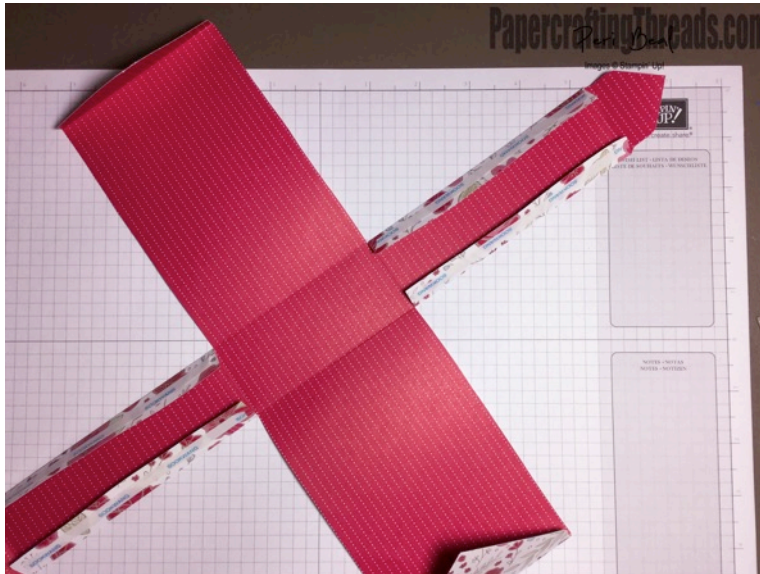
8. Cut the narrow sections **approximately 3/4" outside** of the score lines to make a tab for adhesive. Just eyeball it, as it doesn't have to be exact. In the photo below, the score lines are indicated by the orange lines and the cut line is shown in green.



Here is what the piece will look like when everything is cut.



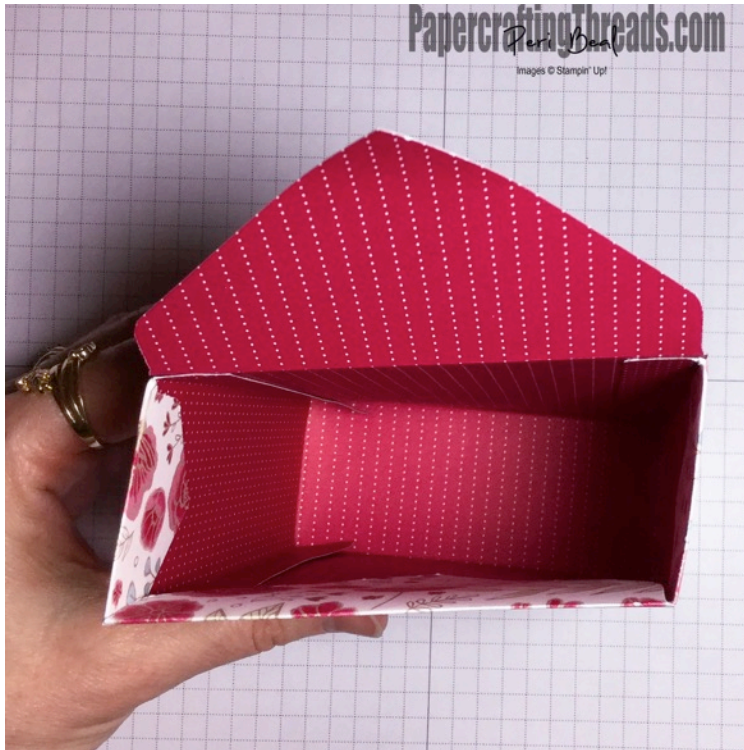
9. Put a strong adhesive such as Tear N' Tape on the tabs created in Step 8 and fold on all score lines. The wider panels are the front and back of the pouch, and the narrow panels will be the sides.



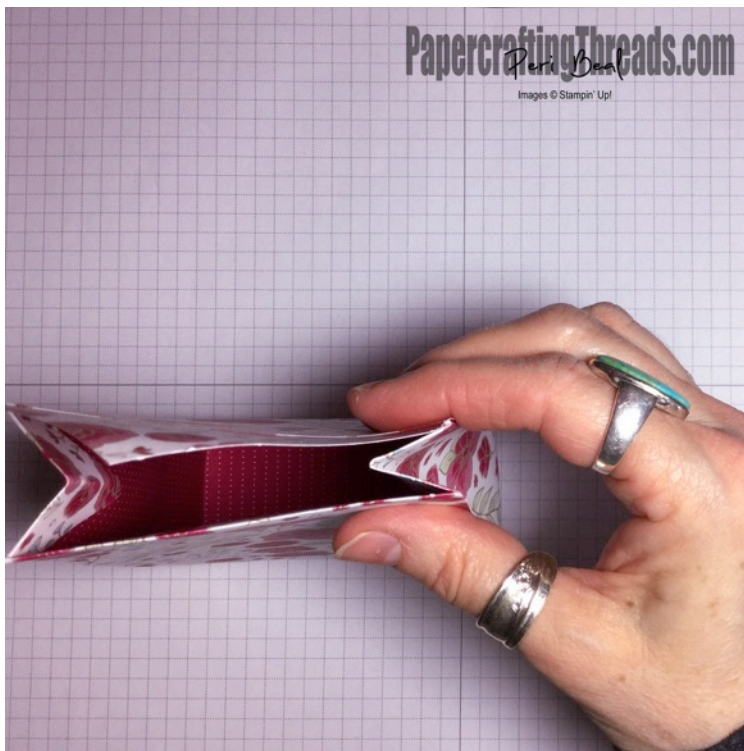
10. Remove the adhesive liner from one tab, butt the edge up against the corresponding wider panel and adhere. Repeat until the pouch is assembled.



11. Push the side panel flaps and the front panel flap into the inside of the pouch.



12. Gently pinch the edges as show to form side panel gussets.



13. Using a ½" circle punch, punch two holes spaced evenly over the closed flap.



14. Insert ribbon and tie in a pretty bow. Decorate as desired!
