Cutting & Scoring Guide

Granny Apple Green 5 ½" x 8 ½", score long side at 4 ¼"

Granny Apple Green 3" x 5 ¼", score short side ½", 1½" & 2½"

Basic White 4" x 5¼"

Basic White 78" x 2½"

Three patterns of DSP, cut three strips each ¾" x 3¾"

Instructions

- Prep all paper as noted. Fold and burnish card base stand.
- Mountain fold the center scoreline on the narrow piece of Granny Apple Green. Valley fold the outer two scorelines.
- Apply Tear & Tape the length of the piece on each of the two 1/2' tabs facing up.
- Lay the base down in landscape position and open flat. Remove the backing from one of the tabs, and lay it face down towards the bottom of the base, leaving an 1/8" border.
- Remove the remaining liner and close the card front to adhere.
- Emboss the large piece of Basic White with the embossing folder and adhere to front of stand with liquid glue.
- Place three strips of Tear & Tape horizontally on the back of a mini calendar and adhere to lower right corner. (See my free downloads for a 2025 calendar you can print yourself.)
- Stamp the greeting in Melon Mambo ink on the strip of Basic White cardstock, add dimensionals to the back and adhere to stand front above the calendar.
- Add liquid glue to the back of the strips of DSP and adhere on the left.
- Ink the large toadstool cap first in Versamark ink, then in Melon Mambo ink. Add Clear Embossing powder and heat set. Repeat with the small toadstool cap, substituting Fresh Freesia.
- Ink and stamp the stems in Early Espresso ink. Punch out the caps and the small stem. Fussy cut the large stem.
- Place dimensionals on the back of the caps and adhere to the front over the DSP strips. Cut strips of dimensionals to apply to the back of the stems. Add a drop of liquid glue at the top of the stem before adhering to the caps.
- Scatter sequins near toadstool caps
